sounds of o and ree tryi-, try to make breath sounds that make (sky) mine (me) to breathe

(see breath out in front of you as a white mist in the cold air

or some school teacher reading us a story
about the arctic and how cold it can get
it was so cold someone's words were frozen in the air
and centuries later when it warmed up
language popped out right in front of them
right out of the air
breath
which makes sound from my body
air which flys out of me
through o and ree
oooooory
breaking open as spittle would crackle in the frozen air

(horizon of ocean swells and tides something like old sealskin strip of seaweed necklace box of cedar air to hold for me til I get back) ok I get a sense of it now breath can reach my toes I can take there the thought and breath goes with it simple exercise mechanics image disconnected out beyond the foot remember hw hw question and answer remember the only bird of poetry the night Sanskrit "to breathe" out only empties the container a handful of dead toenails hw hw

thuh moon
huh wu wu
nguh nguh nguh

The name is Chinese from Cantonese grandfather who came out to railroad work. And then English and then Swedish. From 1939 Swiftcurrent, Saskatchewan to Trail and Nelson where I "thickened" to Coast university New Mexico New York and back since 1967 in the mountains now to teach at Selkirk College, build the house with Pauline, Jenefer and Erika, watch it all happening.

The four poems in this anthology are part of a series of pieces which are thematic cycles. "breath" and "sound" are obvious parts of a paradigmatic thought-rhyme overlapping with "death", "heart", "family", etc. in other pieces. The process is simply one word at a time, one line at a time, one piece, and so on. I find I look for any music therein. "as he leaves her" uses a coast Native story to feel out what might be available to the whole story. "mmmmmm" is sounds of breathings while seeing the moon. From up here in the mountains the poem looks like the signal of a great intensity in language, an unavoidable configuration of thought and sound, still.



New West Coast is the most important book of contemporary B.C. poetry in print. It contains over 250 poems never before published and short autobiographical sketches as well as personal commentaries by the poets themselves. The poets included are:
